### Who is it for?

This course is aimed at language teachers at all levels of knowledge and experience. The course is delivered in English.

### What are the aims

### How is the course set up?

The Developing Teachers course is divided into 4 modules - Setting Off, Breaking Through, Moving On & Stepping Up - which means that whatever your experience and background there is a course for you. In addition the course is planned in such a way that it can be adjusted to suit the needs of the participants. Therefore, before every course we send out a questionnaire to find out more about the participants and the kind of support they want.

### Why should I do a course like this?

As teachers we believe that learning is a vital part of life, that when we commit to do something we should aim to do it to the best of our ability and not be afraid to change, adjust and develop.
