Using Pictures and Images to Review Language

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- → <u>Visual Aid</u>: provide concrete visual representations of concepts, making it easier for them to understand and remember information
- → <u>Engagement</u>: they are attention-grabbing
- → <u>Multisensory Learning</u>: cater to various learning styles, ensuring a more comprehensive learning experience
- → <u>Vocabulary Development</u>: word association
- → <u>Cultural Awareness</u>: introduce different cultures, traditions, and environments
- → <u>Assessment and Feedback</u>: allow teachers to gauge a child's understanding and provide feedback more effectively

- → Secret Flashcard






Using drawing to practice English
