- > Favourite...?








Wrangling



- Choose a dialogue consisting of two short sentences expressing disagreement.
- In pairs say the dialogue as an argument.
- You are only allowed to use the words in the text but vary the stress, gesture and tone to try to convince each other!

'The answer is no.'
'But why? It's not fair.'



'I don't want to hear any excuses. You're fired!'

I come from a small village in the northern part


country. I lived there until I went to university in Warsaw.

Don't say yes or no



- In small groups
- One person answers questions (cannot say yes/no)
- The others ask questions
- One minute time limit or change when the person says yes/no.
