The course consists of 3 x 90 minute sessions per day including:

- input of new teaching methods and hands-on experience with activities
- analysing the rationale behind the teaching methods and procedures with your tutors
- discussing and potentially implementing adaptations of these activities to suit your own classrooms.
- microteaching where you will teach your peers in the course by using some of the techniques and/or activities you have learned.
- feedback which you will receive from our trainers after your microteaching.

In addition, the course is planned in such a way that it can be adjusted to suit the needs of the participants. Therefore, before every course we send out **a questionnaire** to find out more about the participants and the kind of support they want.
